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## "ACCESS- Social Space Orientation in Youth Work 4.0"

A living democracy needs the commitment of all - also and especially of young people. The Corona pandemic, however, has significantly limited the participation opportunities of young people, especially those with fewer opportunities. This is where the "ACCESS" project comes in. In Berlin, Vienna and Valencia, project partners develop participation offers and test them with young people in the neighbourhood. They get the opportunity to become experts in peer learning with other young people. This is combined with counselling and further training for youth work staff. The result will be a model for social space and needs-oriented youth work outside formal education that can be used throughout the EU and is tailored to young people with fewer opportunities. The model is intended to show what conditions for youth work to succeed might look like and what need for action there is for research and policy.

### **Guiding Questions**

- How can disadvantaged young people be empowered?
- What do young people understand by self-determination and how can it be acquired?
- How can key skills be built up to be able to recognise one's own rights and formulate wishes?
